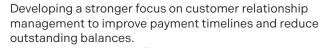

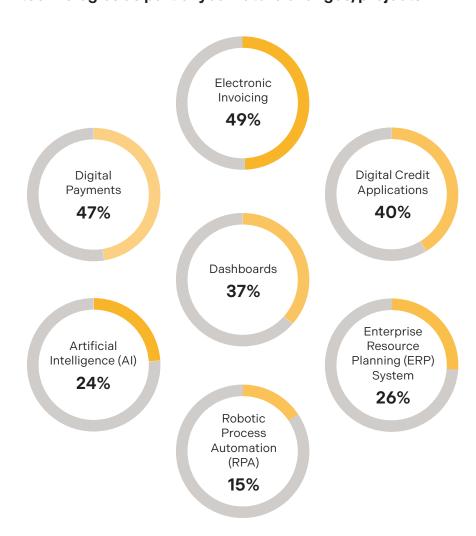

Budget approved, fully ready and equipped for change to automation.

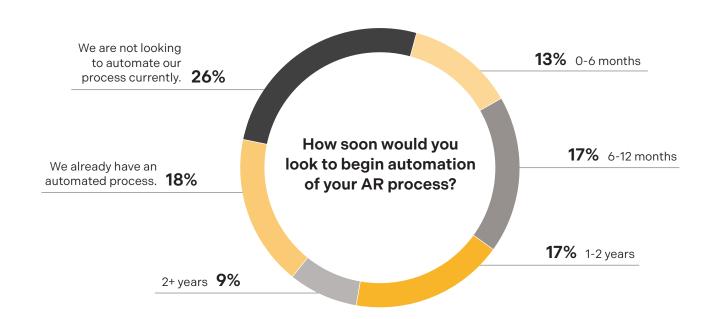

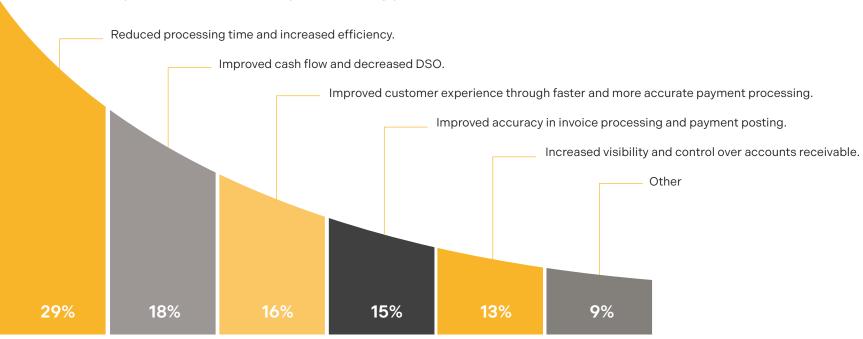

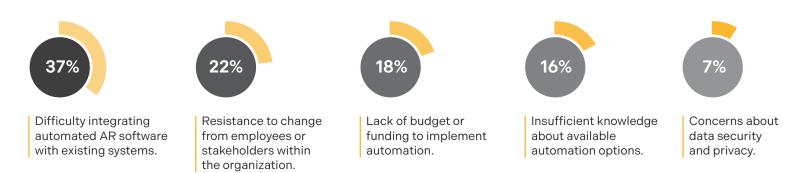




What do you hope to achieve by automating your accounts receivable process?



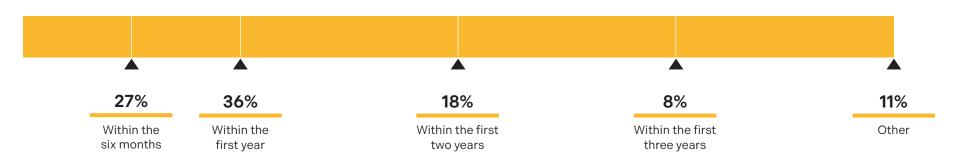
If you are ready, or mostly ready to change to an automated AR process, what has stopped you so far?



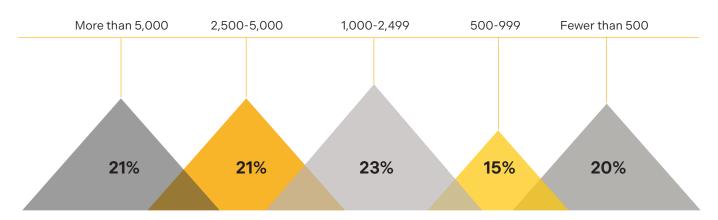




What time frame, post go live, would you expect to see a return on investment from an automated AR process change?

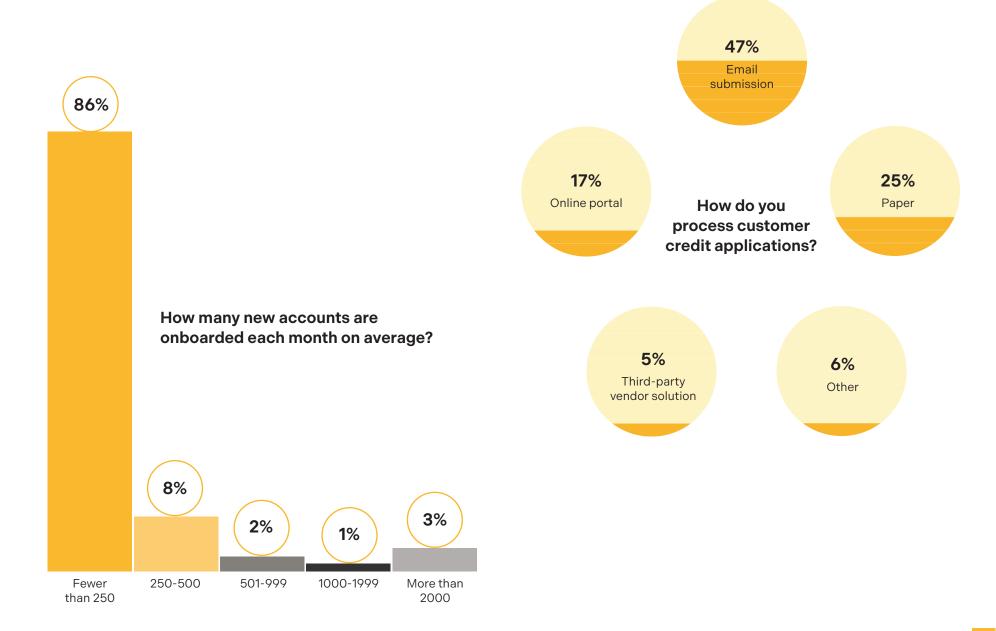


How many active customers do you currently have in your accounts receivable portfolio?



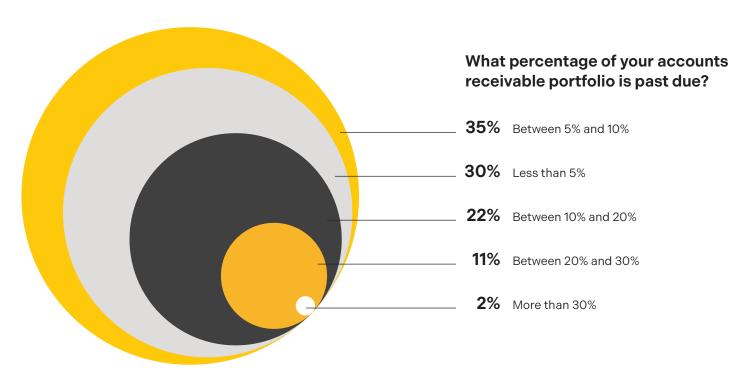


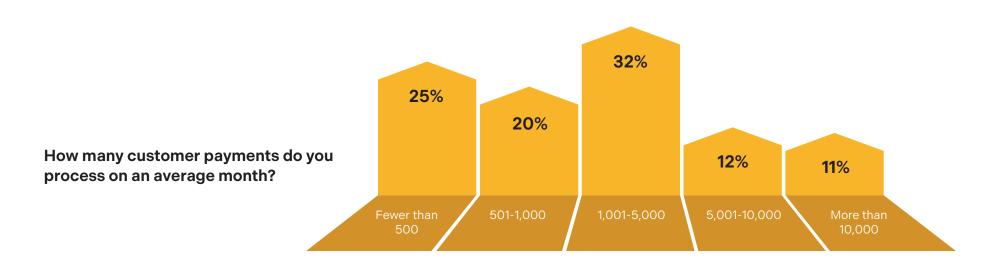








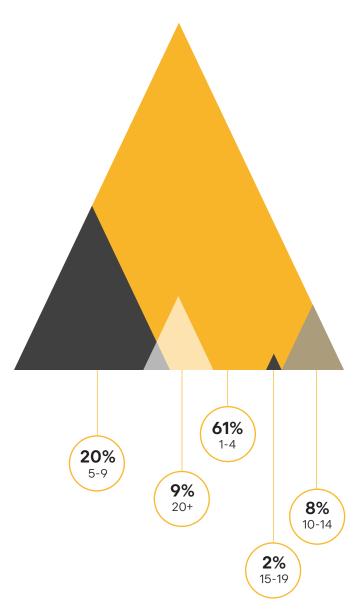


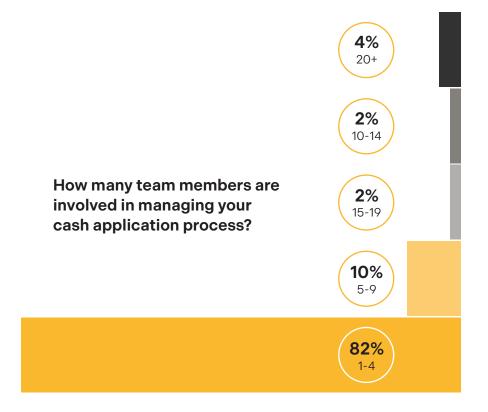






How many team members are involved in managing your collections process?

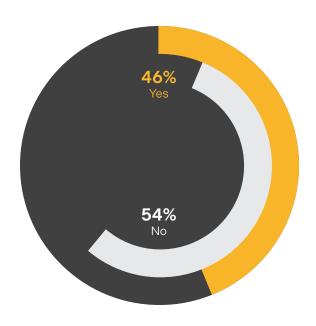


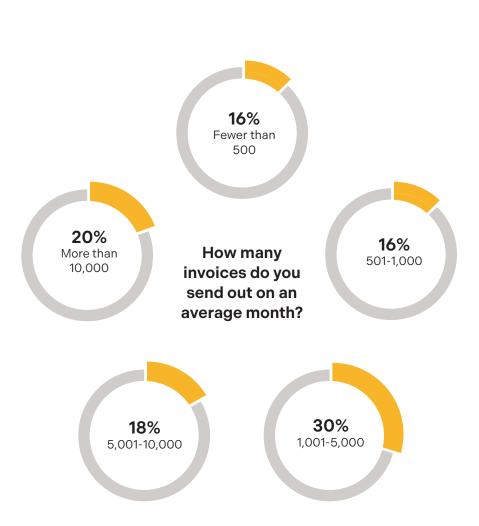






Do your collections teams help apply payments during busy periods?

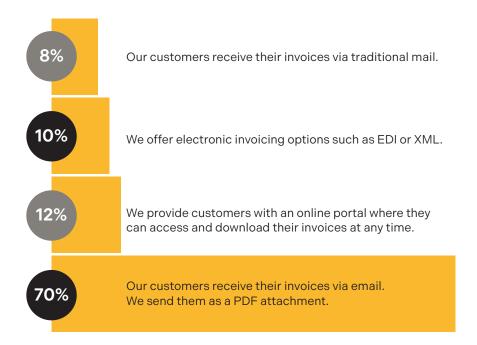




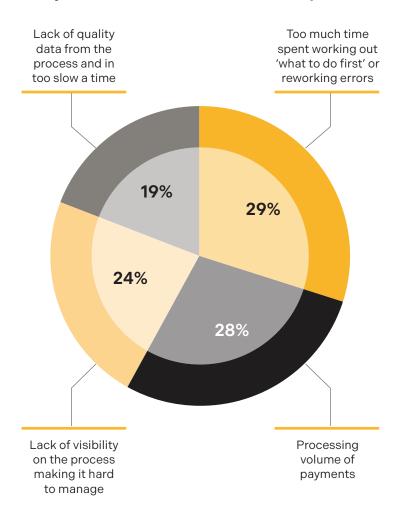
